Dean Bleadorn has witnessed many evolutions in respiratory therapy in his 35 years of experience — in fact, that's part of what drew him to the field.

"It changes all the time," said Bleadorn, a registered respiratory therapist and respiratory care manager at a 532-bed hospital in Cedar Rapids, Iowa. "The therapy is always moving in different directions. It's not the same mundane stuff all the time."

Case in point: Bleadorn and his team used to perform much more manual therapy on patients. With the advent of high frequency chest wall oscillation (HFCWO), that has fallen off significantly. "One of the primary values is you can use HFCWO concurrent with other therapies," Bleadron said.
"Patients like it, and it produces results. It's just an effective therapy that has worked well for our therapists and our patients."


His first introduction to the therapy came about 15 years ago when the hospital acquired some devices from a competitor of the SmartVest System. When Bleadorn and his team got the chance to choose, however, they selected the SmartVest.
