Caregivers to people with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS), often referred to as Lou Gehrig's Disease, know that this progressive neurodegenerative disease affects nerve cells in the brain, brain stem and spinal cord. As motor neurons degenerate, so does muscle control and even lung function. Decreased ability to move air in and out of the lungs heightens the risk of lung infection.

People with ALS need regular airway clearance therapy to loosen and remove retained secretions — which allow bacteria to accumulate and thrive — in order to reduce the risk of lung infections. In some cases, airway clearance therapy includes suction or Cough Assist techniques. Because of the rapid progression of the disease, oral airway clearance techniques such as handheld oscillating PEP devices can be ineffective, since patients don't have the expiratory force needed to complete the exercise.

When prescribed treatments for improving airway clearance associated with ALS don't provide effective relief, there's another option: SmartVest® Airway Clearance System.

The SmartVest Airway Clearance System uses high frequency chest wall oscillation (HFCWO), a <u>proven clinical therapy</u> that helps to clear the lungs of excess mucus, reducing the risk of respiratory infections and hospitalizations. The <u>SmartVest System</u> consists of an inflatable garment connected to a programmable air pulse generator. During therapy, the SmartVest garment delivers a rapidly repeating pulse of air, alternately squeezing and releasing the upper body. Each squeeze simulates a "mini cough," which acts to loosen, thin and propel mucus toward major airways, where it can be more readily coughed up or suctioned away.
