If you're the parent or caregiver of a child with cerebral palsy, you know the symptoms of the disorder range from mild to severe and vary from person to person. Cerebral palsy is a blanket term referring to a group of disorders that involve brain and nervous system functions that affect a person's ability to move and maintain balance and posture.

With cerebral palsy, there are numerous areas of overall health that need to be monitored, but one of the most important is respiratory health. Because of muscle weakness, people with cerebral palsy may have swallowing difficulties, a weak cough and seizures, which can impair their ability to effectively cough up mucus. When this occurs, more serious respiratory complications can result.

To help clear mucus from the airways, a doctor may prescribe several airway clearance techniques, including manual chest physiotherapy (CPT) with postural drainage and use of breathing devices that vibrate the airways. However, these airway clearance techniques may not be tolerated by all people with cerebral palsy.

When prescribed treatments for improving airway clearance associated with cerebral palsy don't provide effective relief, there's another option: SmartVest® Airway Clearance System.

Each squeeze simulates a "mini cough," which acts to loosen, thin and propel mucus toward major airways, where it can be more readily coughed up or suctioned away.
