If you're the parent of a child with muscular dystrophy or have the condition yourself, you know that the condition can affect different people in different ways. In many cases — particularly in the most common form, Duchenne muscular dystrophy — the condition affects the muscles associated with breathing. As lung muscles weaken, the ability to cough up mucus can be impaired and mucus can pool in the lungs, allowing bacteria to thrive. The result can be an increase in lung infections and ultimately respiratory failure.

However, routine airway clearance can help keep the lungs free of germ-harboring secretions and reduce the risk of infection. In order to promote airway clearance, a physician may prescribe manual chest physiotherapy (CPT) and postural drainage, as well as handheld oscillating PEP devices. But you or your child may have trouble tolerating the positioning and percussion that manual chest physiotherapy requires. And handheld devices can prove inadequate for the level of airway clearance that's required.

When prescribed treatments for improving airway clearance associated with muscular dystrophy don't provide effective relief, there's another option: SmartVest® Airway Clearance System.

Each squeeze simulates a "mini cough," which acts to loosen, thin and propel mucus toward major airways, where it can be more readily coughed up or suctioned away.
